Legislation recently enacted by the City Council allows the City to levy fines against offenders. The more stickers they catch, the bigger the fines, so we need to report as many as possible.

Tell 311 it's a Department of Sanitation complaint, get a complaint number, and follow up to ensure that the complaint is acted upon.
