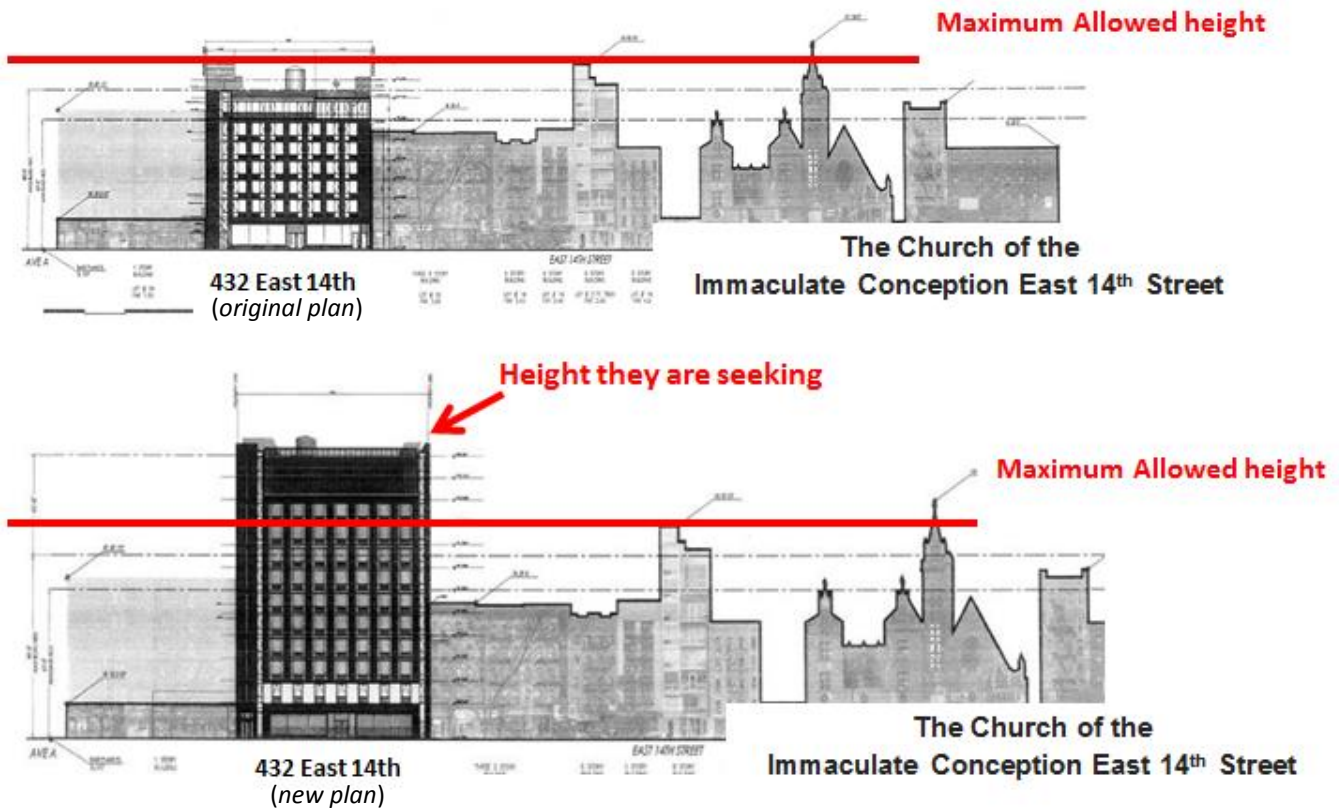


Do you live in Stuyvesant Town or the East Village?
