Description: A Colonial Revival style public bath house originally designed by Renwick, Aspinwall & Tucker and built in 1906-1907, and later altered in 1922 by Jaros Kraus and in 1929 by Mitchell Bernstein. Application is to install a rooftop fence.

COMMISSION FINDINGS

The Commission NOTED that the building's style, scale, materials and details contribute to the architectural and historic character of the New Greenwich Village Historic District Extension II.

Pursuant to Section or 25-318 of the Administrative Code of the City of New York, the Commission RECOMMENDED THAT A POSITIVE REPORT BE ISSUED, FINDING:

-that the construction of the fence will not damage or eliminate any significant features of the roof;

-that the metal mesh playground fence and enlarged bulkheads will be mostly visible over secondary facades and only visible at an oblique angle over the primary south façade;

-that the portions of the fence will be seen in a context of taller buildings and will be contstructed from a thin wire mesh material, and therefore will not call undue attention to itself;

-that the new fence will align with the height of the staircase bulkhead;

-that the enlargement of the parapet is necessary for the construction of the fence, will not remove any decorative masonry, and will be minimally visible from the public thoroughfare;

-and that the proposed work will not diminish the special architectural and historic character of the building or the historic district.
