

Town Hall Meeting:

NYU HAS DROPPED THE 400 FT. TALL TOWER PROPOSAL, BUT NOT THEIR MASSIVE EXPANSION PLANS — WHAT DOES THIS MEAN, AND WHAT DO WE DO NEXT?

The announcement by NYU in the face of widespread opposition, including from architect I.M. Pei, that they were dropping their landmarks application for a 400 ft. tall tower in Silver Towers was a tremendous victory. ***But their massive proposed expansion plan has not gone away. What does this change mean, and what are our next steps?***

NYU is proposing to add about 2 million sq. ft. of space around Washington Square Park over the next twenty years — the equivalent of the Empire State Building — and another 1 million sq. feet throughout the surrounding neighborhood. But their plan cannot move ahead without extensive approvals from city and elected officials, and that public approval process will begin in the new year. **YOU can affect whether or not these approvals are granted.**
