To Fight the NYU 20-Year Expansion Plan

NYU is seeking City approvals to add 2.5 million sq. ft. of space – the equivalent of the *Empire State Building!* – to the blocks south of Washington Square Park. To do this, they are asking to strip long-standing neighborhood zoning protections, eliminate open-space preservation requirements, undo urban renewal deed restrictions, and take over public land used as parks.

NYU's massive plan would not only overwhelm and have a huge impact upon the immediate area, but the entire Village and surrounding neighborhoods, setting dangerous precedents to allow overbuilding and remove neighborhood protections.
