We write to inform you that your client, Bayrock/Sapir Organization, LLC ("Bayrock"), is currently in violation of an April 30, 2007 Restrictive Declaration (the "Declaration") that was executed and recorded related to its building at 246 Spring Street in Manhattan.

Pursuant to Section 2.04 of the Declaration, the New York City Department of Buildings ("DOB") must receive, no later than March 31 of each calendar year, an annual unit occupancy report, certified by an independent certified public accountant. To date, DOB has not received any such reports.
